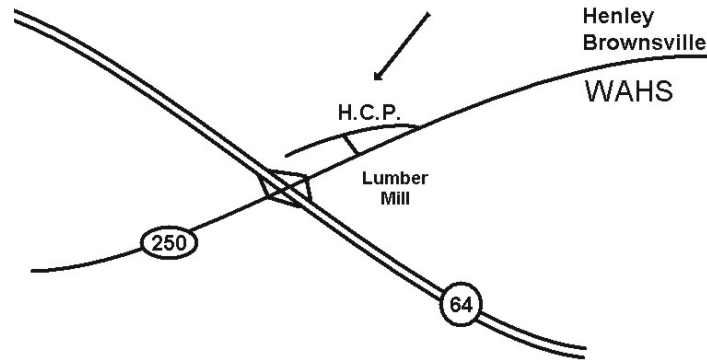

Curriculum

There really isn't a "typical" preschool day. Children are busy with many different activities each day, but your child's day will include the following basic activities:

Free choice time: Your child will have the opportunity to choose from a variety of activities for a part of the morning. This may include building blocks, an art project, puzzles, small toys or games at the table, playing in the home living area, looking at books or other activities.

Clean up time: Your child will help take care of our rooms and resources by picking up and returning toys to their proper places.

Circle times: Your child will learn to listen to each other and his teacher, select his helpers for the day, count the days in the month, check out the weather for the day, enjoy reading books, play games, and sing songs during this time.



Outside play: We will spend some time out on the playground everyday that the weather permits.

Snack time: The children will bring a nutritious snack from home to eat as they share conversation with their friends and practice good table manners.

Resting: Each class will have a few minutes of quiet time when the children will listen to quiet music or look at books.



Classes

We have a class for 2 ½ - 3 year olds, 4 year olds and a pre-kindergarten class for older 4 year olds and younger 5 year olds. Our classes begin at 9:00 each morning and conclude at 12:00 noon. We have 3 classes with 10 children in each class. We have 3 loving teachers and one aide who all have experience in working with young children and are active members of a local church. We require that children be toilet trained unless the child has a physical disability that prohibits training.
